Born and brought up locally, Danielle spent her childhood years developing her love of music in the Gloucestershire area before moving to Bath in 2009 to gain her degree. In 2012, she proudly earned her Honours degree in Music from Bath Spa University, specialising in vocal studies. Following this, she continued to develop her professional singing career through solo and ensemble work with choirs and in the theatre, across both the UK and Europe.

Throughout her career, Danielle has taken on prominent roles in various productions. Notable among these are her portrayals of La Ciesca in Puccini's *Gianni Schicchi*, Pleasure in Handel's *The Choice of Hercules*, Venus in Purcell's *King Arthur*, and Miss Sherman in a concert rendition of *Fame!*

In addition to her solo work, she has sung as a first soprano in esteemed professional choirs such as Bath Camerata and the Turner Choir. Not content with her performance career, Danielle branched out as an educator. She established her own teaching enterprise, sharing her knowledge as a private singing and piano teacher. She also served as a vocal coach and musical theatre teacher in various academies and schools throughout the county.

Danielle's passion for musical education extended to her role as the Musical Director and Director for a Musical Theatre Youth Group in Gloucester. Her directing and musical directing credits encompass a wide range of beloved productions, including *Fame!*, *Oliver*, *The School of Rock*, *Joseph and His Amazing Technicolour Dreamcoat*, *The Nightmare Before Christmas*, *Matilda Jr*, and *Mary Poppins Jr*.

In more recent years Danielle has focused her attention on her family life and teaching career, getting married in 2017 and becoming a mother in 2020. In 2017 she also earned her PGCE from the University of Gloucestershire. After two teaching positions in Gloucestershire and Worcestershire, she assumed the role of Assistant Director of Music at The King's School, Gloucester in September 2022.
